Contest Rules, Regulations and Guidelines:

V.L.Q. Contest:

- Five to eight men from the same chapter
- Chapters may have more than one V.L.Q. entered
- V.L.Q. may be configured as desired as long as there is at least one man per part
- V.L.Q. 's will sing one barbershop song of their choice
- Please register your V.L.Q. by Saturday afternoon between 4:00 and 6:00 pm
- A traveling trophy with the name of the winning chapter and V.L.Q. will be awarded
- All members of the V.L.Q. must be members of the Barbershop Harmony Society in good standing.
- The Judging panel will consist of certified judges or candidates (when possible), in accordance with Society Contest & Judging rules.

Novice Quartet Contest:

- No more than two men that have competed in society sanctioned quartet contests (District, Prelims or International) will be allowed
- All members of the quartet must be members of the Barbershop Harmony Society in good standing.
- The quartet must have a name that is not registered to any other Society (BHS) quartet. The quartet may be registered with the Society, but is not required to be.
- Quartet will perform two songs
- The Judging panel will consist of certified judges candidates (when possible), in accordance with Society Contest & Judging rules.

“Luck Of The Draw” Contest:

- Quartet will perform one song
- Judging criteria will be decided by the judges
- You may sing any or all part(s)
